WHY RELIGION & ENTERPRISE IN AFRICA?

In Africa, belief systems are dominant, and it is regarded as the most faith-based continent in the world (Dodd and Seaman, 1998)

 Business and socio-economic activities are often flavoured with belief-based expressions and rituals, (Emani and Nazari, 2012).

Over 490 million Africans live in extreme poverty; high unemployment and inequality (UNCTAD, 2021).

In 2021 alone.....

• 15 active armed conflicts were registered. (Fabritius, 2021; Mishra, 2021; CFR, 2022).

Four military seizures of governments took place in Chad, Mali, Guinea, and Sudan (UNDP, 2021; WHO, 2021).

There were fires, floods, droughts and famine from worsening climate change (UN, 2021).

African market, comprising 1.4 billion people and a combined GDP estimated at over \$6.7 trillion in purchasing power parity. (UNCTAD, 2021).

Mass of 30 million square kilometers 3 times bigger than China, and second largest continent on earth.

 Vast amounts of natural resources, especially those in demand for a green fourth industrial revolution (UNCTAD, 2021).

The paradox.




The period 2023–2050 will present huge opportunities for humankind, due to continuing advances in arts and sciences,


